Researchers are focused on increasing understanding of adults who are nonverbal or have limited use of verbal language. Eligible participants and their caregivers will be invited for an in-person visit at UCSF. Abilities will be assessed through a series of activities with adults and

interviews with parents. Families will receive a brief summary of assessment results and a \$50 gift card for their time.

To be eligible, participants must be:

- 18 years old or older
- Nonverbal or use of limited spoken language (use of augmentative and alternative communication strategy or device is allowed but not required)
- Able to walk independently
